Kyle is a small business owner by day, podcast editor by night, and loves all things outdoors.

Tsh is an experienced travel guide, high school literature teacher, and author of six books including *At Home in the World:*

Reflections on Belonging While Wandering the Globe. She also writes for publications like *America Magazine*, *Public Discourse*, *Word on Fire*, and more. She is a long-time podcaster and currently co-hosts *A Drink With a Friend*, a show that explores what it means to see all of ordinary life through a sacramental lens.

Both of them are Catholic converts after spending most of their lives as devoted evangelicals, followed by Anglicans. They're beyond grateful for discovering where they belong after years of searching for where they could best find the presence of Jesus. There's little that gets them more encouraged than connecting ecumenically with brothers and sisters, wherever God has them, and sharing real-world experiences together.

Their favorite style of travel? Laid-back adventure. When you travel with them, you'll try new things and ask new questions about the world and your place in it, but not at the cost of unwise risk. We'll learn from locals, trod on old soil, and spend time each day unpacking what we've learned — often over a pint or a glass of something unique to the culture. They'd love you to join them!

ITINERARY



June 20, Thursday | Day 1: Depart for Greece

We depart on an overnight flight from Newark to Athens. Dinner and breakfast will be served on board.

(Add-on airfare from most major airports, as well as premium and business class upgrades, are available upon request.)

June 21, Friday | Day 2: Welcome to Greece!

We arrive in Athens and meet our English-speaking Greek guide who will accompany us during the land portion of the trip. We'll begin our trip at the Catholic Church of St. Dennis, where we'll celebrate Mass. We'll then settle into the hotel and enjoy a Greek dinner before getting a well deserved night of rest. Overnight in Athens.

(breakfast & dinner included)

June 22, Saturday | Day 3: Delphi - Osios Loukas

After breakfast we'll drive to Delphi, the center of the ancient world and "navel" of the earth, whose prestige extended far beyond the boundaries of the Hellenic world. On the slopes of Mount Parnassus in a landscape of unparalleled beauty lie the ruins of the pagan Sanctuary of Apollo Pythios. We then visit the Orthodox Monastery of Osios Loukas, dedicated to the local hermit and healer, Holy Luke. The monastery is considered one of the most beautiful in Greece with a treasury of priceless icons. Dinner and overnight in Athens.

June 23, Sunday - Day 4: Athens

Following Mass with the local faithful in Athens, we embark on a city tour. Athens is one of the most glorious cities in the world and the cradle of western civilization as we know it. We visit the Acropolis: the rock that has dominated the panorama of Athens for twenty-



five centuries. There, we'll see the ruins of the Parthenon, Erechtheum, and Propylaea, then ascend Mars Hill, where St. Paul spoke to the Athenians about the one and only God (Acts 17), and finally see the ancient Agora, the former public center of Athenian life. The afternoon and dinner are free to explore the city on your own. Overnight in Athens.
(breakfast included)

June 24, Monday | Day 5: Start Our 4-Day Aegean Cruise /

After breakfast we'll board the Celestyal Olympia, then settle into our cabins and explore the ship. Beverages are included, so grab a cool drink and meet on the deck as we depart the mainland and enjoy the beautiful views. Our first stop is the island of Mykonos, the most cosmopolitan of the Greek islands which attracts visitors from all over the world. After docking, we'll head to Hora, the island's capital, and leisurely explore the narrow, cobble streets of the city, pass by chic boutiques, elegant nightclubs, and whitewashed houses to arrive in Alefkandra, known as the "Venice of Mykonos" with historic homes donning wooden balconies built on the sea for the wealthy merchants and captains. We'll then return to the ship for dinner and our overnight. *(breakfast, lunch, & dinner included)*



June 25, Tuesday | Day 6: Kusadasi – Ephesus & Patmos

After breakfast on board we'll disembark at the lively Turkish port of Kusadasi, then head to the small village of Mt. Koressos where we'll visit the small stone chapel on the site where the Virgin Mary spent her last days following Christ's crucifixion. We'll continue to ancient Ephesus and begin our walking tour, which takes us through the most magnificent excavations in the world. The last stop on the walking tour is the Great Theater, with a capacity of 25,000 people, where St. Paul preached. We'll then follow the exact route that Mark Anthony and Cleopatra once rode in procession via the Arcadian Way. This main street runs from the Great Theater to the main city's harbor.



We'll return to Kusadasi and enjoy free time to explore on our own before boarding the ship, when we then stop in Patmos, where we'll visit the Monastery of St. John the Theologian. This marvelous structure was built 900 years ago and continues to stand strong. In addition to the stunning main church with outstanding frescoes, we'll view the beautiful courtyard, dining room, and bakery.

We'll then head to the small museum which houses priceless ecclesiastical treasures such as books, manuscripts, mosaics, icons, textiles, vestments, and jewelry. We'll then board a bus to the Monastery and Grotto of the Apocalypse for a once-in-a-lifetime experience to stand at the site where the Book of Revelation was written. We'll return to the ship for dinner and our overnight. *(breakfast, lunch, & dinner included)*

June 26, Wednesday | Day 7: Rhodes

The island of Rhodes is a mix of Roman and Byzantine architecture, as it was one of the most important seafaring and trading centers in the Eastern Mediterranean during ancient times. It's now under the protection of UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. We tour Rhodes together in the morning, then you'll enjoy free time to explore on your own. You may return to the ship for our included lunch, or enjoy lunch on your own in town. An optional



excursion to the ruins of Lindos, an ancient fishing village on Rhodes, may be purchased on the ship. Dinner and overnight on the ship. *(breakfast, lunch, & dinner included)*

June 27, Thursday | Day 8: Crete & Santorini

We'll head to the largest city on the island of Crete, Heraklion, to see the ancient ruins of the Palace of Knossos, discovered in 1899 and partially

reconstructed. This ancient palace is believed to have housed the mythical Labyrinth of King Minos and is the seat of ancient Minoan culture. It's also the site where St. Paul met the owner and captain of the ship who warned him about continuing his missionary journey

to Rome. We'll return to the ship and sail to the idyllic island of Santorini, the most breathtaking of all the Greek

Islands. We'll take the cable car to explore Thira, with its iconic white-washed houses, narrow streets, open-air cafes, and glittering boutiques that cling to steep cliffs. We'll then enjoy our last dinner & overnight on the ship.

(breakfast, lunch, & dinner included)



June 28, Friday | Day 9: Corinth of St. Paul & Winery

We'll disembark our ship and drive to ancient Corinth. Under the shadow of the towering Acropolis, St. Paul lived in Corinth for two years, where he grieved over the spiritual formation of its still-young church and ultimately wrote four letters here. We'll explore the remains of first century shops, the site of St. Paul's trial by Gallio, the Fountain of Peirene, and the Temple of Apollo. In the late afternoon, we'll enjoy a lunch stop and a winery tour to learn about local wine. Dinner is at leisure. *(breakfast & lunch included)*



June 29, Saturday | Day 10: Athens

We'll enjoy a day at leisure in Athens to explore the city, visit a museum, or simply soak up the local atmosphere. Tonight we'll come together for our farewell dinner with Greek folklore dancing. *(breakfast & special dinner included)*

June 30, Sunday | Day 11: Head Home

Today marks the end of our odyssey. We'll say our heartfelt farewell to a pilgrimage that will last in our memories, then head to the airport for our return flights home. *(breakfast included)*

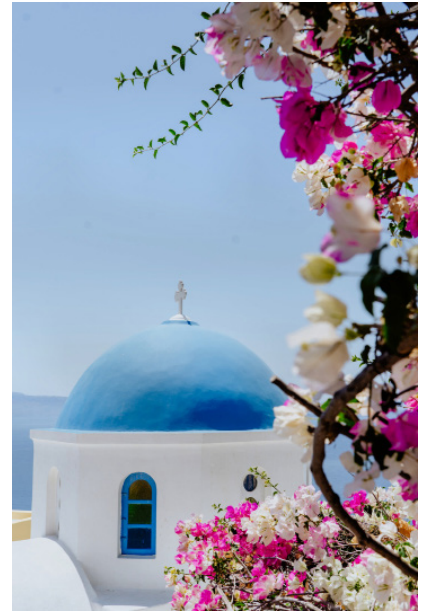

Your passport must be valid through December 30, 2024. Reservations will not be processed until we have passport copies. Prices quoted are based on payments by check. Prices: **\$3,595.00** for land only (air not included); **\$1,300.00** for group air (estimated air price, exact price will be available at the end of July); **\$4,895.00** for land and air; **\$1,395.00** for solo traveler, additional cost, (in room by yourself). For credit card prices add 4%

PILGRIMAGE PRICES: Prices are based on minimum 20 passengers. Prices may be adjusted in the event of fewer than 20 passengers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices are in US dollars. For European travel an exchange rate of US \$1.05 per Euro is assumed.

SOLO TRAVEL: A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee roommates but will do our best to connect you with a someone willing to share.

LAND ONLY OPTION: Land only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time, otherwise, transfers are not included.

TOUR CANCELLATION POLICY: Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$350.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 90 days or more before departure. A \$500.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 90 and 60 days prior to departure. Within 60 days of departure all payments are non-refundable regardless of reason for cancellations. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice. You may be eligible for a refund through your travel protection. Select International Tours) controls seating assignments. If you require very specific seats, we suggest that you book your own airfare and take advantage of our "Land Only" options. You may communicate directly with the airline to request seating changes, provide mileage program information, or change passenger contact information once you receive ticket numbers—approximately three (3) weeks prior to departure. We work with instant purchase airline tickets and or group rates. If you switch from air and land to land only within 90 days from departure you will be charged a \$100 service fee in addition to any airline charges. All special needs and requests due to medical or dietary restrictions must be requested in writing at least 60 days prior to departure. Business class and Premium Coach seats are available upon written request; as are add-ons from your hometown airport. If you require very specific airlines or schedules, we suggest that you book your own airfare and take advantage of our "Land Only" options.
